

## **November at Home Sunday School Plan**

### **Grades 2 -3**

Every Sunday ask your child the following questions

- What are the 4 Gospels (They should respond in a cheer that they know from Sunday School)
  - Matthew, Mark, Luke , John
- Why are the Gospels important, why do we stand in church for the Gospel
  - Because it is Jesus's words
- Have your child find a comic strip in the Sunday newspaper (or online if you do not get the newspaper) and have them relate the comic strip to "Everyday life / Everyday faith" If you do not get the Sunday paper and want to use the comic strips, please text me and I will send some pictures back. 989-878-2884
  - There is no wrong answer here. This is their view on life and how it connects to their faith.
- End Study time with the Lords Prayer or ask your child to "Freestyle" a prayer

November we will be doing a scavenger hunt. Students who attempt this will get a treat at the next meeting the first week of December.

### **Where in the Bible:**

November 8 –

- Where in the bible was Moses given the 10 commandments (Book / Chapter) –
  - Read this with your family
  - Discuss rules you have in your home
  - Ask what the most important commandment is that was given to us

November 15 –

- What is the name of the first book in the bible?
- Where are the gospels located in the bible?
  - Find Matthew 25 14-30 , read the parable as a family and discuss what types of talent each member of the family has that God has given.
- What is the name of the last book in the bible?
- Where in the bible did Jesus provide us with the Lords Prayer?
  - Might want to use index or table of contents or even internet if you cannot find it.

November 22 - Christ the King Sunday

- Find Matthew 25 :40 read as a family
  - Create a Thank you card for someone in your family
  - Start a family prayer that can be said before dinner on thanksgiving, every person says one thing/person they are thankful for
- Find – Pick a page, any page in one of the 4 Gospels, Pick a chapter and a block of 10 verses. How many times does the word Jesus show up in those verses?

November 29 - First Sunday of Advent!!

- Today we start the countdown to Christmas.
  - Discuss as a family what you do to prepare for Christmas
  - What is the best part of Christmas?
- Find – who was John the Baptist
  - Find matthew 3:2 and read as a family
  - What did John the Baptist wear?
  - What did he eat?
  - What did he do for others in the river?
  - Who was John talking about when he said one is coming who is more powerful than I?
